### NOTICE OF RACE

**Saturday - Sunday, November 2-3, 2019**

**Hosted by Mesa Model Yacht Club - AMYA # 146**

**Eligibility:** Any owner/skipper of a Victoria Class boat, who is properly registered in the Victoria Class and a current member of the AMYA, or his/her appropriate national authority, may participate in this regatta.

**Entry:** Any eligible owner/skipper may enter the regatta by completing and returning the attached Entry Form (or on-line registration through AMYA), together with an appropriate check, to the address indicated. The Entry Form must be signed and postmarked no later than October 18, 2019. Entry will be restricted to the first 30 paid entrants. Late entries may be accepted if space is available.

**Regatta Site:** The regatta will be sailed at Dobson Ranch Lake; Mesa, Arizona. For venue photo, map, directions see Club web site.

**Lunch will be provided with entry fee at lakeside both days, Saturday ~ 12:00 – 12:30 pm,  
Sunday ~ 11:30 – 12:00 pm.**

**Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current 2017-2020 (RRS) Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by Appendix E, the Sailing Instructions and the US Victoria Class Rules. The sailing instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this NOR.

**Racing Format:** The Race Committee will determine the number of races for each day after considering weather, course and equipment conditions. Six (6) races are to be completed to constitute a regatta. If there are more than 15 entries, racing will be conducted under a Heat Management System, as outlined in sailing instructions.

**Awards:** AMYA Gold Chevrons will be awarded for top three places. In addition, Event Trophies will be awarded to the top 5 finishers.

**Frequency Assignment:** Participants should list all of their available radio frequencies on the regatta entry form. Frequency assignments will be handled on a first come, first served basis. Every effort will be made to assign one of the frequencies listed on the entry form. If a frequency conflict arises, the applicant will be contacted and informed of the alternative frequencies still remaining.

**Sailing Instructions:** A copy of the Sailing Instructions, frequency assignments and final schedule will be e-mailed to all entrants no later than a day after close of entries.

**Inspection:** All boats will be inspected for conformance with Victoria Class Rules at time of registration. Measurements will include verification of minimum weight and keel depth, as well as other aspects as determined by the Class Secretary. All boats must display sail numbers on both jib and main!
